## Knowledge Corner

### Q2: Does Islam prescribe punishment for apostasy?

Islam does not prescribe death for [apostates](#), the Holy Qur'an was the first religious scripture to categorically declare, "There shall be no compulsion in religion". The Holy Qur'an addresses disbelief more than 150 times, yet man is never given authority to punish a disbeliever. The Holy Qur'an repeatedly states that Muslims, including Prophet Muhammad, can only advise and not punish anyone, and that too only regarding religious matters.

## Knowledge Corner

### Q5: How does Sharia Law tie in with the laws of the land? How does it affect Muslims and non-Muslims? Do all Muslims support Halal certification and the slaughtering of animals according to Halal methods?

Islam teaches that religion cannot be forced upon Muslims or non-Muslims. The principles that incorporate sharia law are intended to develop and sustain a moral and just society. If the law of the land prescribes this, then there is no reason why Muslims should find it difficult to obey the law of the land, and still abide by shariah law.

Islam provides guidance for a pure and healthy life. Regarding the concept of halal foods (permissible/lawful) the Holy Quran says - "He has made unlawful to you only that which dies of itself, and blood, and the flesh of swine, and that on which the name of any other than Allah has been invoked. But he who is driven by necessity, being neither disobedient nor exceeding the limit, it shall be no sin for him. Surely, Allah is Most Forgiving, Merciful." [\(2:173,174\)](#)
