Knowledge Corner

Q77: In the Holy Quran Ch8:V47, does Islam only refer to being non-violent towards other Muslims and being violent against all other non-Muslims?

This verse is about the enemies of the Muslims during a specific incident, and the verse is to warn and prepare the Muslims for when the enemy strikes again. This was a warning to Muslims to not be complacent in their victory at Badr, warning them that the enemy at that time was going to keep attacking them with larger forces and war equipment. Hence the Muslims were told to hold firm and not to waver in the persistent attacks that were coming.

Again, the part that says "remember Allah" is in reference to the fact that as the enemy would call on to their allies, so should the Muslims whose only ally and reliable help is Allah.

Furthermore, as the Quran is for the people of all times, the relevance of these verses in our present time is that; currently, the "enemy" uses writings, social media and verbal means to attack Muslims, our beliefs and our advocacies. Muslims of our time are therefore to educate themselves very well on every topic necessary, not be complacent in certain victories, and that Muslims should stand firm and be ready to defend Islam and humanity at every front. Again, we Muslims are to remember that our only reliable source of support is Allah and it is only with His help will we be victorious in our plight to defend and save humanity.

However, the verse also talks about the fact that irrespective of Muslims being prepared for the onslaught of the enemy, they should always tread on the path of peace. We should consistently use peaceful measures to resolve our differences with those who strive to tarnish our image. And should we *ever* have to use force, it should be after we have been attacked (in self-defense) and no other peaceful means can be used.
