Majlis Ansarullah Victoria Region held its general meeting with Respected Sadr Sahib Majlis Ansarullah Australia on Sunday 27th September 2020. The conditions in Victoria, since March 2020, did not allow the Region to hold any event as the Government had locked down the Melbourne especially with a restriction of movement beyond 5 km radius. Therefore, in order to address Ansar members of Victoria, a general meeting was arranged online in place of the Regional Ijtema.

The meeting started with the recitation from the Holy Quran followed by Ansarullah Pledge. Knowledge Corner

Q12: Is it true that there is no compulsion of religion in Islam? Moreover, should we not associate any government with Islam? Is the separation of state and religion a pre-requisite for peace?

This is correct. The Holy Prophet (peace be upon him) was instructed clearly that "Admonish, therefore, for thou art but an admonisher; thou art not appointed a keeper over them" in the Holy Quran. This also evidently shows that even the Holy Prophet (peace be upon him) was only responsible for the plain delivery of the message and not its imposition. Thus, any religious compulsion would therefore function in direct opposition to what the Holy Quran states in <u>Verse 257 of Chapter 2</u>.

This is also why MuslimsDownUnder.com recognises that separation of state and religion is a must in order to achieve peace.
